I used this tool to cut around the image of the model in order to create a second layer for the masthead to be placed around. Once I had created all the layers, I placed the masthead behind the first layer of the image so it appeared to be behind the model. I used the lasso tool in order to cut around the model.

The text tool was used to create the masthead. I did the font large and bold as the masthead is one of the most important aspects of any genre of magazine. The masthead was placed behind the models head to create dimension.

The cropping tool was used to enlarge the image on the cover. The original image was from further away, but to avoid unnecessary white space around the model, I cropped it to make the view of the model closer and clearer.

The spot healing tool was used to eliminate any blemishes on the image, in particularly on the models face. For a stereotypical magazine look, I made my models face look flawless to conform with this typical idea.
